YOUR ITINERARY

Jun 15 UNITED STATES TO DUBLIN

Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as you travel to start your vacation.

Jun 16 DUBLIN ARRIVAL & SIGHTSEEING

After landing at Dublin Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. Then your CIE Tours driver/guide will welcome you to Ireland and escort you and your luggage to the coach. Take an orientation drive around Dublin city center. Dublin is one of the liveliest capitals in Europe but there are plenty of historical places also. See the main thoroughfares of O'Connell Street and Nassau Street, the shopping streets and some lovely public parks. Stop in Trinity College to view the 8th century Book of Kells, an illuminated manuscript of the gospels. Then drive to your hotel and check in. After you settle into your room you may like to rest or explore some of the city on your own. In the evening join your fellow travelers for a welcome drink followed by dinner in the hotel restaurant.

FULL IRISH BREAKFAST AND DINNER & OVERNIGHT: DAVENPORT HOTEL, DUBLIN

Jun 17 DUBLIN SIGHTSEEING & MERRY PLOUGHBOY EVENING

After breakfast set off on a special tour of Dublin with views from both land and water on a Viking Splash tour. Board an amphibious vehicle for this unique and amusing excursion. After your land tour, splash into the water at the Grand Canal Docklands where the recording studio of U2 and much more are explored. After your tour drive to the Lambert Puppet Theatre, the only purpose built Puppet Theater in Ireland. From fairy tales for children to Oscar Wilde for adults, the theater offers something for everyone. The enchanting performances will hold you in your seats until the very end. Then visit the Guinness Storehouse to see exhibits on how this world famous stout was first created and why it is so

popular today. Finish your visit in the roof-top bar, Gravity, overlooking the city center where you can sample a draft Guinness and enjoy the view of the city. Return to your hotel with time to freshen up before dinner.

This evening drive to the town of Rathfarnham to The Merry Ploughboy Pub for dinner followed by a lively show of traditional Irish songs, dancing and music.

FULL IRISH BREAKFAST AND DINNER OVERNIGHT: DAVENPORT HOTEL, DUBLIN

Jun 18 MUSEUM OF COUNTRY LIFE & WESTPORT

Leaving Dublin travel across the country via the marketing centers of Mullingar and Longford. Travel through farming country and a number of small towns where you can see how many Irish people live. Stop to visit the Museum of Country Life, which is situated in the grounds of Turlough Park House and Gardens which was built by Charles Lionel Fitzgerald in 1865. The exhibitions portray the lives of ordinary people who lived in rural Ireland in the period 1850 – 1950. The museum is also home to the National Folklife Collection which comprises of objects dealing with agriculture, fishing and hunting, clothing, architecture, vernacular furniture, trades and crafts, transport, sports and leisure and religion. Then drive a short distance to Westport and check into your hotel. Enjoy the balance of the day at leisure for independent activities before joining your group for dinner.

FULL IRISH BREAKFAST AND DINNER & OVERNIGHT: HOTEL WESTPORT, WESTPORT

Jun 19 RUMCLIFFE CHURCHYARD & DONEGAL

Today travel northeast through County Mayo and into Sligo, a county of gentle mountains, lakes and coastline. This area is associated with one of Ireland's most influential poets, W. B. Yeats. Visit the Drumcliffe Visitor Centre to see his grave and a display about his life and work. Then continue your drive along the shores of Donegal Bay and into Donegal to check into your hotel. Enjoy some time to relax and settle in before joining your group for dinner.

FULL IRISH BREAKFAST AND DINNER & OVERNIGHT: MILL PARK HOTEL, DONEGAL

Jun 20 DONEGAL SIGHTSEEING

Donegal, with its windswept hills where only sheep can thrive, is renowned for wool production. Drive to the fishing port of Killybegs and on to Teelin to view Slieve League sea cliffs, where the highest point reaches 1,972 feet making them the highest in Europe. The cliffs drop straight down to the wild Atlantic waves below and you will see marvelous vistas. Continue through the majestic Glengesh Pass and stop en route to enjoy a picnic lunch with your fellow travelers. Then drive on to Ardara to visit Triona Design. See demonstrations of spinning, weaving and knitting. Feast your eyes on hilly scenery as you return to Donegal town. Enjoy some free time in the town center before returning to your nearby hotel in time for dinner.

FULL IRISH BREAKFAST, PICNIC LUNCH, AND DINNER & OVERNIGHT: MILL PARK HOTEL, DONEGAL

Jun 21 Giant's Causeway & dunboyne

Today travel along the north coast of Ireland through the towns of Londonderry, Limavady, and Coleraine to visit the Giant's Causeway. This impressive area of hexagonal columns was formed more than 60 million years ago by the slow and even cooling and contraction of molten lava. Then travel through the "Nine Glens of Antrim" for wonderful views of mountains, valleys and coastline. Drive through Belfast and south through Newry and Dundalk with views of the Mountains of Mourne in the background. Continue your drive to the village of Dunboyne just to the northwest of Dublin and check in. In the evening join your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner in the hotel restaurant.

Jun 22 RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES

All too soon, your vacation in Ireland has come to the end. Transfer from Dunboyne to Dublin Airport in plenty of time to check in for your flight, clear security and claim your VAT refund. You may do some last minute shopping at the duty free stores. Then clear U.S. Immigration before boarding your aircraft and fly west across the Atlantic Ocean back to the United States.
